GP CONTRACT CHANGES GPC SURVIVAL GUIDE UPDATE

Further to the LMC Newsflash issued on 9 April 2013, the General Practitioners Committee (GPC) has now issued guidance on changes to the Quality and Outcomes Framework (QOF) as follows:

- Major clinical changes have been made to the QOF, including changes rejected by the GPC during negotiations. - Upper thresholds have been increased for 20 QOF indicators to match upper quartile achievement. The remaining upper thresholds will similarly increase from 2014. After 2015 upper thresholds will continue to rise with overall achievement.
- Most of the organisational indicators in QOF have been removed.
- The time period for achieving most QOF indicators has been reduced from 15 to 12 or 27 to 24 months. - The Contractor Population Index (CPI) in QOF will be changed to reflect current average practice populations. The value of QOF points will be increased in April 2014 to make this change cost neutral in year one.
