## GP CONTRACT CHANGES GPC SURVIVAL GUIDE UPDATE

As noted in the LMC Newsflash issued on 26 March 2013, the General Practitioners Committee (GPC) is in the process of producing guidance on the GP contract changes in the form of a survival guide. Parts of this guide have recently been made available as follows:
