## ELECTRONIC REFERRAL SERVICE (eRS) EXCLUSIONS

Following apparent confusion regarding which routine services are currently excluded from eRS, we have received the following update:

Please note that the Sheffield Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust list has been updated since the version distributed to practices via Sheffield CCG's e-bulletin dated 1 May 2018.

It has been agreed that changes to the lists will be kept to a minimum.
